I just want to say a big thank you to all for the help and support that you all give me. You all make my job so much fun! We sure did have a good New Year didn't we.

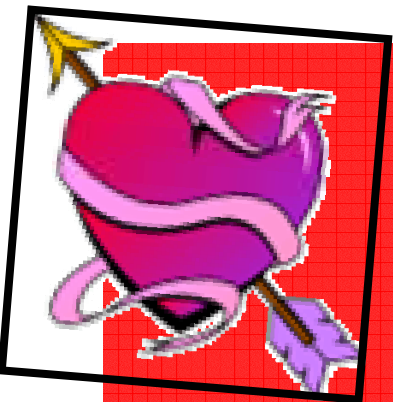
